TOURNAMENT RULES

ELIGIBILITY: All participants must be USBC SANCTIONED and current members of the CAPE COD TEN-PIN USBC. <u>All members must present sanction cards</u>. If a participant is not USBC SANCTIONED, they MUST fill out a sanction card and pay the sanction costs.

If a participant is USBC SANCTIONED but not a current member of the CAPE COD TEN-PIN USBC the participant MUST pay an association fee of \$10.00 Payment of this fee allows the entrant to participate in this tournament as well as bowl in leagues in this association. Unmarried entrants under the age of 18, or grade/high school students must complete and submit, with the entry form, a parental consent form approved by the USBC.

- 2. The Tournament Champions will have their State Tournament Team Event entry fee paid for by the CAPE COD TEN-PIN USBC. No cash will be paid to the Tournament Champions for the State Tournament Entry if they are unable to attend the State Tournament. The second or third place team will attend in their place. At least 3 members must be part of the original team.
- 3. Ties for first place will be decided by a roll-off of one (1) game with **TOTAL** pin count deciding the winner. The Tournament Director will choose the roll-off date, time, and lanes at the Tournament Center.
- Squad times will be filled as entry applications are received. <u>The Captains will be notified only if their CHOICE of time slots cannot be honored.</u>
- 5. Replacement (substitutes) bowlers **MUST** be requested at least 30 minutes before the scheduled squad time. Replacements (substitutes) for "All Events" **MUST** be established **before** the substitute bowls.
- 6. A BOWLER MAY PARTICIPATE IN MULTIPLE EVENTS, FOLLOWING USBC RULES. Team Captains must check in at least 30 minutes before the scheduled squad time with all Team members sanction cards. Doubles/Singles partners must check in together at least 30 minutes before their scheduled squad time with their sanction cards. If you bowl doubles, you must also bowl singles. YOU CAN CASH ONLY ONCE IN SINGLES. Multiple team entries must have at least 2 different members. (USBC Rule 315)
 - For ALL EVENTS Award consideration, the bowlers FIRST event series bowled will be used to determine All Events status.
- 7. The participants (bowler) entering average MUST be their highest (ending) USBC sanctioned average for the 2023 2024 bowling year. However, if the bowlers average for the CURRENT season (2024/2025) is 10 or more pins higher at the time of the tournament than the CURRENT average MUST be used.
- 8. If a participant (bowler) did not bowl during 2023 2024 season, then their CURRENT highest USBC sanctioned average for 21 games or more as of January 1st, for the 2024 2025 season MUST be used. All others MUST bowl scratch. A summer league average of 21 games or more is a legal average if it is the highest average.
- 9. All bowlers are responsible for verifying their entering average whether submitted by the bowler or Team Captain or others.

 Failure to provide the correct average will disqualify the bowler for this Tournament. Averages will be verified via BOWL.COM. If the bowler is unsure of their average, bring it to the attention of the Tournament Chairman.
- 10. Full entry fees MUST accompany the entry application form.
- 11. All protests must be submitted to the **Tournament Chairman, in writing, within 48 hours of the event bowled**. All protests relative to FINAL Tournament results/standings MUST be submitted in writing within 48 hours of Results Posting date.
- 12. DRESS CODE: T-SHIRTS WITH INAPPROPRIATE WORDS OR PICTURES (i.e. swearing, unsuitable gestures, or nudes) WILL NOT BE ALLOWED. MUSCLE SHIRTS, NO RIPS OR HOLES IN PANTS. COLLARED SHIRT PREFERABLE BUT NOT REQUIRED....
- 13. ONLY BOWLERS AND TOURNAMENT OFFICIALS ARE ALLOWED IN THE SETTEE AREA. ALSO, NO FOOD OR DRINKS WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE SETTEE AREA.... ELECTRONIC DEVICES MUST BE TURNED OFF OR MUTED IN THE SETTEE AREA.
- 14. USBC Rules that govern Tournament play and not previously mentioned are in effect for this Tournament.***

Per USBC Rule 18, Bowling Ball cannot be cleaned or have any foreign substance during the competition. All bowling balls so altered or cleaned must be removed from the competition including between doubles and singles.
